HUNTER COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL HOME GAME/PRACTICE LOCATIONS:

Hunter College High School , Main Campus.

71 East 94th Street, enter school 94th street btw Park and Madison. All home high school volleyball, basketball and fencing are played at this location.

Take the 6 train to 96th street, walk east on block to 94th street and Park.

(Coming from the West side) Take the M96 bus cross town, exit on Madison Ave. Walk two blocks South.

Central Park (practice)

Used as a practice location for soccer, baseball and softball.

Enter the park on 97th street and 5th Ave.

Dust Bowl

Central Park Reservoir

Enter on 86th street and 5th Ave./ used by the all teams for practice.

Hunter College North Pool

68th Street and Lexington.

Home Swim meets are held at this location. The pool is located in the North building on 68th street. The pool is located in the basement area.

Take 6 train to 68th street, Hunter College Exit

Hunter College Main Gym

This location is used for some playoff games and practice.

68th street and Lexington.

Take 6 train to 68th street, Hunter College Exit.

Hunter College Basement Gym (B4)

This location is used for practice and some playoff volleyball games.

68th street and Lexington.

Take 6 train to 68th street, Hunter College Exit.

You must go down the escalator, then down two flights of stairs to enter the gym.

Hunter College Wrestling room (practice)

68th Street and Lexington.

Located on the main gym level.

North Meadow (Soccer, Baseball, Softball)

97th street and 5th ave / 97th street and Central Park West.

Once you enter the park, follow the walkway. The fields are in the middle of the park. Home soccer games, Home softball and baseball games are played at this location. Middle School and Varsity.

Great Lawn Softball fields

Enter the park on 86th street and 5th ave. Follow the walkway.

181 Lincoln Place. Take the Manhattan Bridge to Brooklyn. As you get off the bridge, you will be on Flatbush Avenue. Continue on Flatbush Avenue for about three miles until you reach 7th Avenue. Turn right on 7th Avenue and go over to Lincoln Place. Go one block further to Berkeley Place, turn left, go up and around back on to Lincoln Place.

From the West Side: Take the West Side Highway north. Exit
after toll on Henry Hudson at 246th Street, Exit 21. Turn right at
light at 246th Street. Turn right onto Fieldston Road. School is
straight ahead.

From the East Side: Take Route 87 to Van Cortlandt South Exit.
Turn right off the ramp and onto Broadway. Turn left onto
Manhattan College Pkwy (before Burger King). Take a right and
continue uphill behind Burger King (Post Road). Turn left onto
246th Street. Go straight until Fieldston Road, and turn left.

By Subway: Take the #1 or #9 train to Van Cortlandt Park & 242nd
Street (last stop). Exit to Broadway and proceed north to street just
before Burger King (Manhattan College Parkway). Make a left and
then an immediate right. Notice hill (Post Road leading to 246th
Street). School is at top of hill on right.

From West Side: Take West Side Highway to Henry Hudson
Bridge. Continue on Henry Hudson Parkway to 246th Street exit.

Turn right at light. Continue on 246th Street for about five blocks. School is on left.

From Westchester: Take Cross County Parkway to Saw Mill River Parkway (south). Exit at 246th Street. Turn left at light and continue for approximately five blocks. School is on left.

From Major Deegan: Exit at Manhattan College and Van Cortlandt Park. From either north or south, turn right at end of ramp and proceed to Broadway and elevated train. Bear right and continue to end of elevated structure. Turn left at light before Burger King (Manhattan College Parkway). Take an immediate right and continue up hill behind Burger King (Post Road). Make a left onto 246th Street; school is on the right at top of hill.

By Train: IRT No. 4 or the IND "D" line to Bedford Park Boulevard. The campus is a three-minute walk to the west. For more information about subway service to the Lehman campus, call the New York City Transit Authority at (718) 330-1234. Metro North's Harlem line has a local stop at the Botanical Gardens station. The campus is about 12 blocks due west on Bedford Park Boulevard. Call Metro North for information about fares and schedules (212) 532-4900.

By Bus: Nine Bronx buses including the 2, 10, 22, and 28 have stops at Lehman College. Liberty Lines BXM4A or 4B express buses from Manhattan stop near the campus, at Bedford Park Boulevard and the Grand Concourse. Good connections are available on Westchester 20 or 20X buses from White Plains, Hartsdale, Scarsdale, and Yonkers via Central Park Avenue. The No. 4 from Yonkers also stops near the campus. For more

information about taking a bus to the Lehman campus, call (718) 330-1234 (Bronx buses) or (718) 652-8400 (Liberty Lines) or (914) 682-2020 (Westchester buses).

By Car: Major highways from Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens, Long Island, Westchester, and New Jersey have exits near Lehman College. The Van Cortlandt Park South exit off the Major Deegan Expressway (I-87) is just a few minutes from campus. Another popular approach is via the Mosholu Parkway exit off the Bronx River Parkway or the Saw Mill (Henry Hudson).

Randall's Island

Take the Triborough Bridge to the Randall's Island exit.

Field #19: Go right at the bottom of the ramp and then bear left immediately. Go straight across the street, and the field will be straight ahead to your right.

Fields Behind Downing: Go right at the bottom of the ramp. Go toward Downing Stadium, follow signs to "GOLF" and go straight toward the water.

Kantor Fields

Follow directions to Ward's Island. Fields are on the left side, past the Psychiatric Center

Red Hook Fields

Take Brooklyn or Manhattan Bridge out of Manhattan. From the Brooklyn Bridge, turn left on Cadmen; from the Manhattan Bridge, turn right on Tillery and then left on Cadmen. Take Cadmen Plaza straight out—it will become Court Street. Go under the Brooklyn-

Queens Expressway. Turn right on Bay Street (softball fields) and then turn left on Columbia. Soccer fields are on left.

River Campus, Lower School.

From Manhattan: Take the West Side Highway northbound (turns into Henry Hudson Parkway) and exit after toll at Exit 21, proceeding through the stop light at West 246th Street. At next stop light, turn left onto West 252nd Street. Cross over Henry Hudson Parkway and proceed approximately 2/10 mile to Independence Avenue. Turn left onto Independence Avenue, continuing past "Wave Hill." Road makes sharp right curve downhill. Entrance to River Campus is first driveway on right.

From Westchester: Take the Saw Mill Parkway southbound to toll (turns into Henry Hudson Parkway). Proceed southbound and take Exit 22, turning left at stop sign. Proceed to stop light. Cross Riverdale Avenue, continuing 3/10 mile. Turn left onto Independence Avenue to stop sign. Cross West 252nd Street continuing past "Wave Hill." Road makes sharp right curve downhill. Entrance to River Campus is first driveway on right.

From New Jersey: George Washington Bridge to Henry Hudson Parkway northbound. Proceed according to directions from Manhattan.

From Manhattan: FDR Drive North to E. 135th Street exit (#12) towards Madison Ave. Bridge. Turn right onto Madison Ave., which becomes Madison Ave. Bridge. Madison Ave. Bridge becomes E. 138th Street. Turn left onto Gerard Avenue. Turn a slight left to take the I-87 North/Maj. Deegan Expressway. Take the West 179th Street exit (#8). Mergo onto West 179th Street. Turn right onto Sedgwick Ave. Turn right onto Roberto Clemente State Park Bridge. Turn right onto Mattewson Road. Buses may park in facility lot after picking up permit in main office; other vehicles may park in the public parking underneath the park facility for a fee.

Roosevelt Island

Local Roosevelt Island Bus: The bus stop is located adjacent to the tramway. The one-way fare is 10 cents. The bus does not accept dollar bills, nor does it dispense change. The bus makes local stops along Main Street, and the final destination is Octagon Park (soccer field). When facing Manhattan, the Pony Field (softball field) is located to the right of Octagon Park.

From Manhattan: Take the upper deck of the 59th Street Bridge to the 21st Street exit. Make a right turn on 21st Street to 36th Avenue. Take a left turn on 36th Avenue to Roosevelt Island via the 36th Avenue Bridge.

From the Triborough Bridge: Take the Triborough Bridge to the first exit (Hoyt Avenue). Make a right on 31st Street (under elevated subway) to 36th Avenue. Make a right on 36th Avenue to Roosevelt Island via the 36th Avenue Bridge.

From Brooklyn: Take the Brooklyn Queens Expressway to Northern Boulevard. Turn left (west) on Northern Boulevard to 36th Avenue. Make a right turn on 36th Avenue to Roosevelt Island via the 36th Avenue Bridge.

From Long Island: Take the Grand Central Parkway west to the last exit before the Triborough Bridge (Hoyt Avenue). Make a left turn underneath elevated subway (31st Street). Make a right turn at 36th Avenue. Proceed to Roosevelt Island via 36th Avenue Bridge.

To the Pool: Once on the Island, turn left at the stop sign and go through town. Go around the field and the rotary—stay to your left (abandoned yellow brick building on right). At the end of the road, go right past the tennis bubble. Get out of bus at fire hydrant and walk up brick path.

USTA Tennis Center Flushing

By Subway Take the IRT #7 Flushing subway from either Times Square or Grand Central to the Shea Stadium / Willets Point Station. The USTA National Tennis Center is about a three-minute walk down the ramp from the station.

Or take the IND "E" or "F" trains to Roosevelt Avenue and transfer upstairs to the IRT #7 train (Flushing bound) subway to the Shea Stadium / Willets Point Station. The USTA National Tennis Center is about a three-minute walk down the ramp from the station.

By Railroad The Long Island Railroad Port Washington branch departs from Penn Station to the USTA National Tennis Center (Shea Stadium / Willets Point Station). Contact the railroad for schedule information at (718)217-5477.

By Car FROM NEW YORK CITY: Take the Triborough Bridge to the Grand Central Parkway (East). Travel approximately three miles until the I-678/RT-25A E/Northern Blvd exit -- toward the Whitestone Bridge (it's exit #9E). Then take the RT-25A E/Northern Blvd ramp toward Shea Stadium. At the exit ramp, make a right onto Stadium Road. Take that road straight until the second stop sign, where you will then take a left. The USTA National Tennis Center will be located on your right.

FROM BROOKLYN: Take the Jackie Robinson Parkway to the Grand Central Parkway (West). Travel three miles toward the Triboro Bridge, exit at the Flushing Meadows/Corona Park/Tennis Center (it's exit #9P). At the end of the exit ramp make a left. Then at stop sign make a right onto Meridan Road. The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your right.

FROM LONG ISLAND: Take the Long Island Expressway/I-495W to exit number 22A, which is the Grand Central Parkway (West). Travel half a mile toward the Triboro Bridge, exit at the Flushing Meadows/Corona

Park/Tennis Center (it's exit #9P). At the end of the exit ramp make a left. Then at stop sign make a right onto Meridan Road. The USTA National Tennis Center is located on your right.

Van Cortlandt

Take 87 North (Major Deegan) to Van Cortlandt South exit. Turn right at the exit and right onto Broadway. The park will be on your right. The baseball field is 1/8 of a mile from the first traffic light; the cross country course is 1/4 of a mile further along Broadway.

Ward's Island

Take the Triborough Bridge to the Randall's Island exit and go right toward Downing Stadium. There is a road next to a closed bridge that takes you to the fields. Bear left at the Psychiatric Center. (You will see green Parks Department signs directing you to Ward's Island.)
